

Wicker Memorial Park Picnic Permit – Rental Terms and Conditions

1. The applicant, his/her organization and members are bound by policy of the “permit,” its terms and conditions, regulations and ordinances pertaining to the use of Wicker Memorial Park property.
2. The applicant submitting a request, listed as the authorized representative, must be a minimum of 18 years of age and present during the entire rental.
3. Any permit may be revoked for misrepresentation in the application or violation of terms and conditions of this application concerning policy, ordinances, rules, regulations, and laws of the State of Indiana.
4. Adequate adult supervision, as determined by a Director of the Park, must be provided at all times. Rental groups may be required to employ security or law enforcement officers should your group exceed one hundred fifty (150) people. (Minimum – 4 hours or \$100.00)
5. Alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted on Wicker Memorial Park property, except when authorized by the Park and when specified on the permit with payment.
6. The applicant, his/her organization and members agree to release the liability of injury to the Wicker Memorial Park, North Township of Lake County, Indiana and its employees caused through said use.
7. Wicker Memorial Park and North Township of Lake County, Indiana will not assume responsibility for lost or damages property.
8. **Use of sound amplification systems, including but not limited to; Bands and D.J.s, is PROHIBITED (excluding Pavilion) . Loud music and vulgarities in music is strictly prohibited**
9. Only Wicker Memorial Park sponsored organizations may use a park building as a mailing address.
10. Any electrical, motorized equipment or temporary structures brought onto Wicker Memorial Park property must be authorized on the permit and purchased through the park.
11. All user groups of Wicker Memorial Park must comply with the intent of the American Disabilities Act and not discriminate in any way.
12. Wicker Memorial Park will close at **8:00 p.m.** and the Pavilion will close at **11:00 p.m. if patron paid for extended time. If patron did not pay for extended time then Pavilion closes at 8:00 p.m.**
13. Children must be supervised at the playground & splash pad at all times.
14. No glass or bottles of any kind allowed on the grounds.
15. No fireworks are allowed.
16. Animals and/or pets are not allowed in the playground. Dogs are allowed on the exterior walking trail on a leash and in the dog run (membership required).
17. No person shall kindle, build, maintain or use a fire other than in designated areas.

18. No person shall park a vehicle any place within the park other than in designated parking facilities.
19. There will be a \$35.00 fee assessed for checks returned due to non-sufficient funds (NSF).
20. Firearms shall not be carried nor possessed in the park.
21. No cooking of whole lambs or pigs will be allowed in any of the open picnic areas.
22. No person shall engage in any commercial or for profit enterprise including but not limited to the offering of services, soliciting, selling, or peddling any personal property, liquids, or food for human consumption or distribute circulars or advertise, peddle or vend any goods, wares, or merchandise within the park, except upon special permit.
23. No person shall injure, deface, destroy, foul or remove any part of the park, building, signage, equipment or other property found therein.
24. All picnics held in the park, pavilion, breezeway, stand, or shelters are subject to inspection, any violation of said rules and regulations shall cause this permit to be revoked.
25. The speed limit for all vehicles within the park is set to 5 m.p.h.
26. No persons except park maintenance employees on duty or law enforcement officers shall enter restrooms set aside for the opposite sex.
27. Proper dress attire is necessary to enter the park. No backwards hats. Skirts and pants must be worn around the waist; shirts must be worn at all times.
- 28. No personal charcoal grills allowed in the park. You may bring gas grills ONLY!**
29. In the event litigation arises as a result of this permit of any collateral matter relating thereto, Wicker Memorial Park and/or North Township of Lake County, Indiana shall have the right to pursue the Applicant for actual damages, attorney fees, court costs, and other related expenses.
30. This park and its facilities belong to the residents of the North Township.
31. Any violation of this contract may result in the removal of entire party.
32. **PICNIC RESERVATION DOES NOT INCLUDE SPLASH-PAD ENTRY FEE.**
